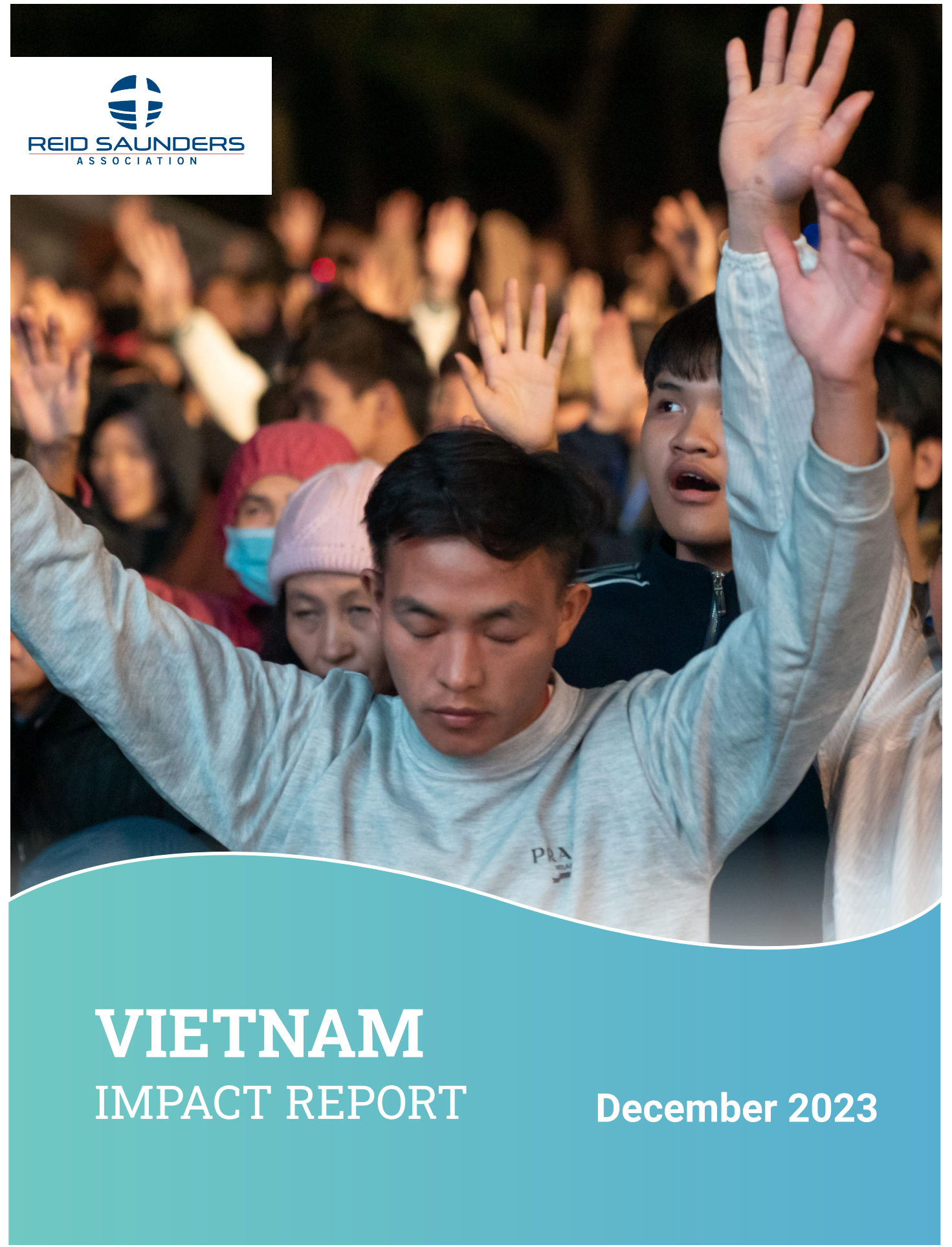

We had such an amazing response to the Gospel that we were invited back next year! The people of Vietnam are so hungry to hear the good news, and we are so grateful for the impact you have had in making this a reality. According to committee member Hien Le, Reid Saunders is the very first evangelist allowed by the government to speak outside in a public place in Hanoi.

Many were gathered together at affinity events in Hanoi! We held a women’s gathering that over 100 women attended and a business dinner teaching men how their work intersects with their Christian faith. Kevin Stone, a partner of RSA, joined us on the trip and got to share his testimony at these two affinity events. We saw many people responding to the Gospel after hearing his story!
