Rayong, Pattaya, and Si Racha | August 2 - 19, 2024





The Lord is at work in Florence and Naples! When we visited our host church in Florence on the last Friday of our outreach, it was almost empty with only about 12 people. On Saturday we did an outreach event, and by Sunday, it was FULL with almost 50 attendees! Encouraged by the turnout, the church plans to hold similar events every three months, as it was the first of its kind in Florence and proved amazingly effective. Praise God!



We thank God that he is always after "the one" and he uses us to be his hands, feet, and voice to bring his message of love to those he is pursuing! While our team was loading the van for an event in Palermo, Sicily, a man noticed us and asked what we were doing. We were in a rush, so we invited him to join us and see for himself. Amazingly, he agreed! On the way, he introduced himself as Gaspare, and shared that he was homeless and living under an awning near our hotel. He even pointed out his bed as we drove by. At the event, we connected him with a church volunteer who found him a seat. Later, we learned that Gaspare decided to give his life to Jesus! A church volunteer followed up and now Gaspare is living with his mom, receiving help from the church through food and essentials. He's currently being discipled, though his mom is still hesitant about the Gospel. Please keep praying for them, especially for his mom to come to Christ.







Name (pronounced "Nam"), a hotel worker who had been serving the team with kindness for several days, was invited to attend the festival by Reid and the team. She graciously agreed and arrived that evening, sitting in a small café behind the main stage. Later the next day, we saw Name again. Feeling prompted by the Holy Spirit, Reid returned to share the message of Jesus with her. She accepted Christ, and a local pastor helped her connect with a church. The team was blessed to see her again the next morning before leaving for their next city.



Our three evangelists from the evangelism training program each preached several times at our events, showcasing the growth they've experienced over the past year. Danny, from Mexico, delivered his messages in English, which were then translated into Thai. For Daniel, this was his first time preaching outside of the US, and Peter, the youngest of the group, grew tremendously in presenting the Gospel throughout the program. They were all well received for their kindness, and the presence of the Holy Spirit was evident in their work. We are so grateful for how far they've come, and encouraged by the effectiveness of our first year of training.



Jesus can be shared across cultural boundaries, even in places where Buddhist religion is deeply embedded. We shared the Gospel at several schools in Thailand, where we had the opportunity to meet 1,500 children who had never encountered Americans before. In Thailand, every school has at least one Buddhist shrine, reflecting how deeply religion and education are intertwined in the culture. We gave a small gift to each principal and to the students, sharing the message that Jesus is the greatest gift of all.
